All foundational prerequisite courses, except SURG 100, must be 5 quarter credits or 3 semester credits.

Register for Program Core Courses

The Surgery Technology Program enters new students Fall Quarter every year and does not have a separate admissions process. Once students have successfully met all the early program requirements they are considered program-ready and are invited to register for first quarter program core courses during their Registration Access Time*.

Students are considered **Program-Ready** for Surgery Technology when they have completed the following:

- Current BTC application on file with Surgery Technology as the program of intent.
- Complete all prerequisite foundational courses with required minimum grades and number of credits. Transcript evaluation process for all courses taken at another institution must be complete.

*Registration enrollment dates for continuing degree/certificate program students are assigned by cumulative credits earned at BTC with student veterans registering first. Generally, continuing students register for Summer and Fall in May, Winter in November, and Spring in February. Check your individual enrollment date in myBTC ctLink. Please register at your assigned time or as soon as you can after it.
